Qualifications to be a Parish Councillor:

If you are a UK or Commonwealth citizen or a citizen of the Republic of Ireland or a citizen of a member state of the EU and are 18 years or over and you are an elector in Denmead OR you are someone who has during the whole of the twelve months before the day on which you applied for co-option (i) resided in the Parish of Denmead OR (ii) within three miles of the parish boundary OR (iii) occupied (as owner or tenant) any land or premises therein OR (iv) had his/her principal or only place of work there.
