### **Correspondence:**

**078/17H** (a) **Furzeley Road/Forest Road:** An email had been received from Cllr Stallard regarding road safety concerns raised by a resident in respect of Furzeley Road and Forest Road. **It was RESOLVED that the Parish Council did not support the provision of a proper footway in Furzeley Road to the junction with Forest Road nor did it support the relocation of the central refuge in Forest Road.**

### **Burial Ground:**

**079/17H** (a) **Applications:** The list of applications received from 18<sup>th</sup> January 2017 to 1<sup>st</sup> March 2017 had been distributed to members for their information. **Noted.**

**080/17H** (b) **Review of Forms, Regulations and Fees:** A review of the current Forms, Regulations and Fees was carried out. **It was RESOLVED to approve the Forms, Regulations and increased Fees with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2017.**

**081/17H** (c) **Change of Grave Digger:** NORSE South East had been appointed as grave diggers replacing Swansborough Garden Services. **Noted.**

### **Footpaths Sub-committee:**

**082/17H** (a) **Minutes:** There were no minutes to receive. **Noted.**

**083/17H** (b) **Matters Arising and Outstanding Matters:** There were no matters arising or outstanding matters to be considered. **Noted.**

**084/17H** **Pyles Farm ~ Drainage Problems:** A grant from SSE to help with the cost of hiring a digger had been sought but was out of time. A new application would be made during the year. **Noted.**

**085/17H** **Finial Rings:** The finial ring and post at Mayswell had sustained further damage prior to it being collected by the engineers resulting in an additional cost of £530 to complete the refurbishment. **It was RESOLVED to approve the additional cost with funds to be taken from SAGE code 3020.**

- 086/17H** Village Centre Planters: It was **RESOLVED** to place an order for four new planters, two at Kidmore Lane car park and two to replace the damaged ones in the village centre and to recover costs from the vehicles insurers for the damaged planters.
- 087/17H** Parish Council Strategy: A progress report was given by Cllr Langford-Smith on the strategy as it related to the Highways and General Purposes Committee. A meeting is to be arranged with HCC regarding Phase II of the works in Denmead. **Noted.**
